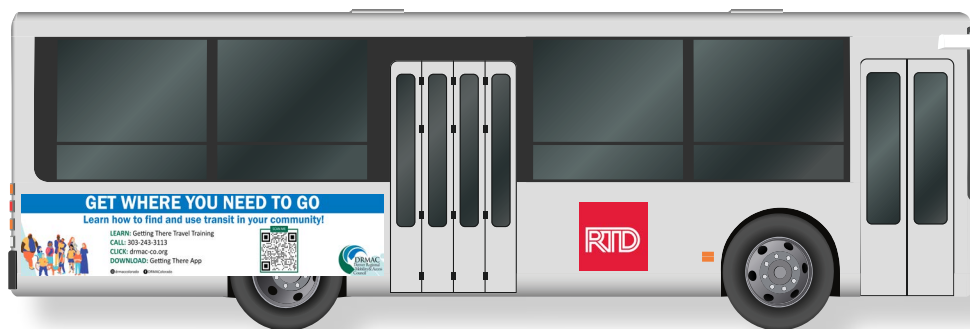

As the Regional Coordinating Council (RCC) for Denver and nine surrounding counties, DRMAC collaborates with community partners and transit providers to eliminate transportation barriers and promote mobility for all.

Program Overview

• Information & Assistance (I&A) Center

DRMAC's I&A Center offers free, real-time, and personalized support to help older adults and others navigate the often-complex world of transportation options.

• Equity in Motion Training Program

Our hands-on training sessions are designed to build confidence in using public transit and alternative modes of transportation. Trainings are available in person, online, in multiple languages, and ADA accessible

Additionally, our Learning Management System (LMS) allows users to complete modules at their own pace. DRMAC also provides technology training to help individuals use smartphones, apps, and other digital tools to navigate transit systems, helping bridge the digital divide.

In response to food insecurity and transportation challenges, DRMAC partners with local rideshare companies to offer free rides, enabling individuals to access food resources safely and reliably.

• Getting There App and Web Tool

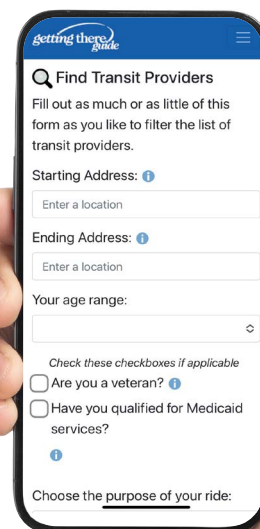

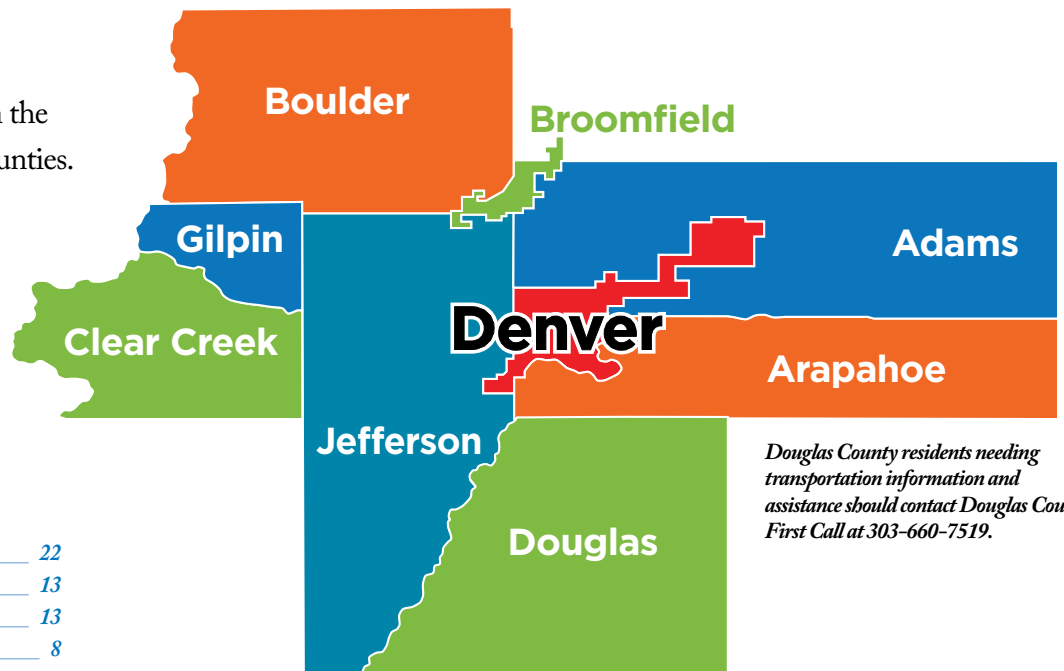

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What We Do

Fare Assistance

RTD, DRMAC and Denver Human Services (DHS) invite Denver Metro residents to visit Colorado PEAK to apply for LiVE: RTD's income-based fare discount program. LiVE provides a 50% fare discount for RTD's fixed route bus/rail services to individuals and families (ages 20+) with limited incomes living in Colorado.

For example, a standard RTD fare valued at \$2.75 would be discounted to \$1.35. For more information visit Colorado Peak or RTD LiVE or call DHS at 720-944-4347.

RTD also offers other discounts for older adults, youth, and people with disabilities. Older adults (age 65+), people with disabilities, and Medicare recipients receive a 50% fare discount. Youth 19 and under ride at no cost. Children aged 5 and younger always ride free with a paying adult. See RTD Fares website for more info.

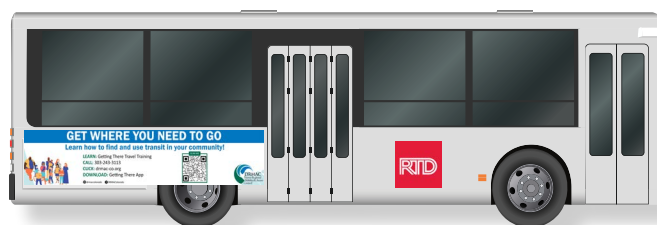
