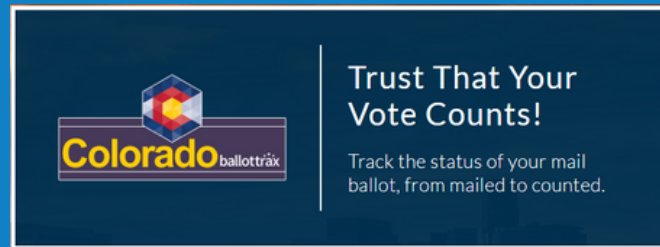


Sunshine Home Share Colorado

The city of Denver, Colorado, is holding general elections for mayor, city council, city auditor, and city clerk and recorder on April 4, 2023 and ballots have been mailed! The BallotTrax system tracks the status of your mail ballot and sends a series of alerts notifying you where your ballot is in the election process, from sent to counted! How to request a ride

1. Enrollment

You complete the enrollment information on the RTD website. Once information is verified, Denver RTD staff uploads your enrollment information to the Uber dashboard.

3. Open the Uber App

5. Select Uber X, XL, or RTD WAV

If the trip is within the service area, you should see the reduced trip fare.

2. Accept the voucher

Upon enrollment, you will receive a text and an email inviting you to add a voucher to your Uber account. Click the link to accept. The voucher will automatically apply on all qualifying trips.

4. Click "Where to?"
