Housing discrimination occurs when a person is treated differently than another person during the sale, rental, or financing of dwellings and other housing-related transactions, based on a particular characteristic they have. Fair housing laws apply to landlords, sellers, brokers, lenders, insurance agents, neighbors, and other people in the housing industry.
